## WHAT'S THE COMMITMENT?


Depending on the specific training category for the position, the annual requirement for IMA positions is 24 Inactive Duty Training (IDT) periods (which equals 12 duty days) and a 12-14 day Annual Tour or 48 IDT periods (24 duty days) annually and a 12-14 day Annual Tour. There is usually flexibility which allows for the scheduling of the training requirements based upon your desire and the needs of the Air Force.

## ABOUT THE IMA PROGRAM

Individual Mobilization Augmentees are reservists assigned to funded positions at active component organizations. They are trained to support their active duty (AD) units and are rated by their AD supervisors. They are essential to the mobilization and deployment system through backfill or by directly volunteering to deploy. Although IMAs are assigned to active component units, the Readiness Management Group at Robins AFB, GA, shares administrative control of these reservists with their assigned units and assists with personnel processes such as promotions and retirement.
